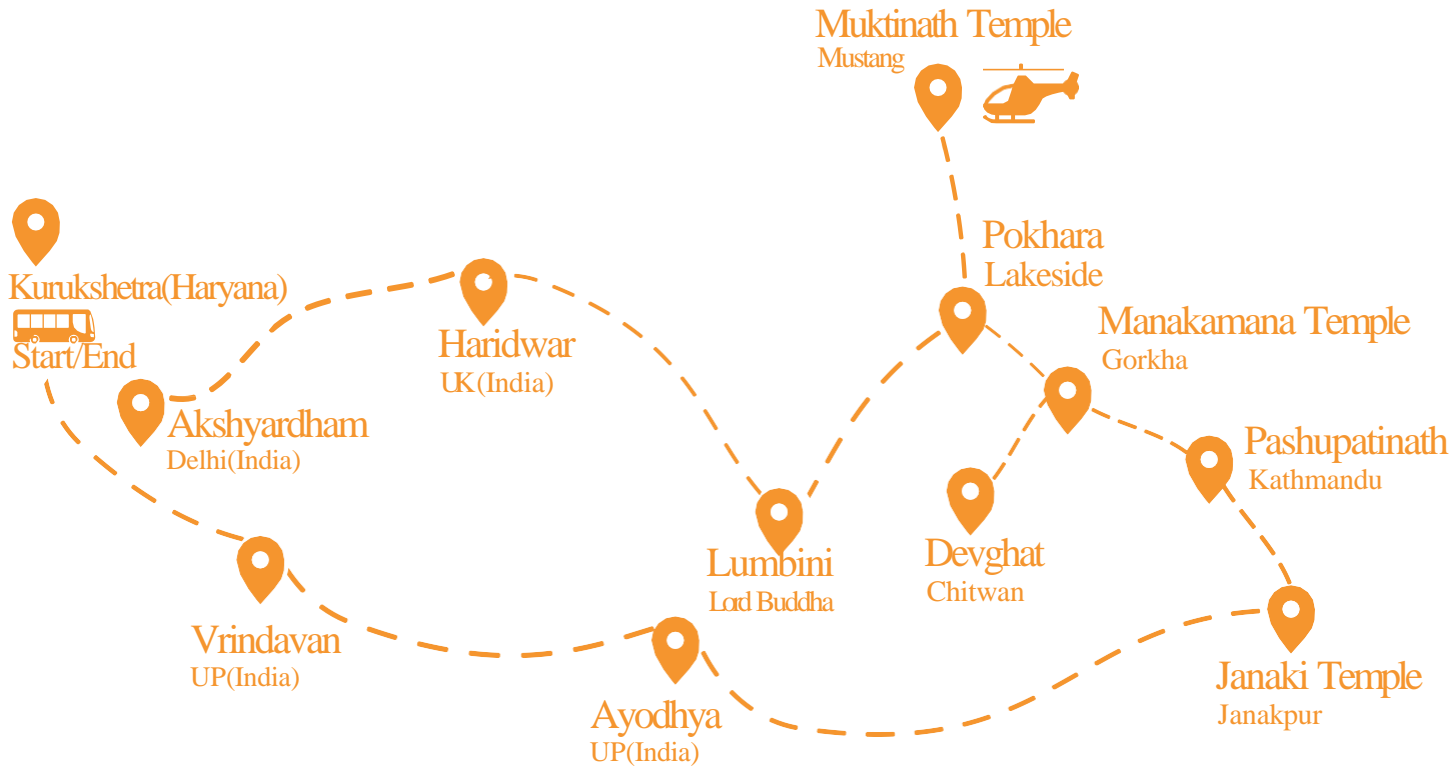

JANAKI MANDIR, JANAKPUR DHAM

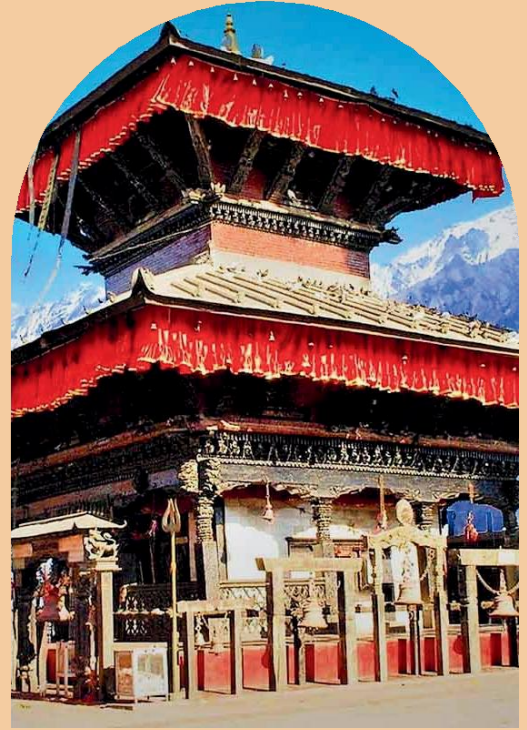

KURUKSHETRA, HARYANA

Kurukshetra is a historic and sacred city in Haryana, India, revered in Hinduism as the site of the epic Mahabharata's great war. It is where Lord Krishna delivered the Bhagavad Gita to Arjuna on the battlefield. Known as the Land of Dharma, Kurukshetra is home to several religious and cultural landmarks, including Brahma Sarovar, Jyotisar (the place where Krishna gave the Gita discourse), and Sheikh Chilli's Tomb. The city is a prominent pilgrimage site, attracting visitors for its spiritual and historical significance.



VRINDAVAN (UP)

Vrindavan and Mathura, located in Uttar Pradesh, India, are sacred cities deeply associated with the life of Lord Krishna.

Devghat symbolizes purity, devotion, and the path to moksha (liberation).



MUKTINATH TEMPLE MUSTANG

Perched at an altitude of 3,800 meters, the temple is dedicated to Lord Vishnu and symbolizes salvation and spiritual liberation.
